Subject: Convergence of Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana with PMAY-G regarding:-

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's OM P-18027/14/2019-P&P dated 26th August, 2020 enclosing Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment letter no. 16015/06/2020 –CC (PMAGY) dated 23th July, 2020 pertaining to above captioned subject.

2. In this regard, it is stated that the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment is implementing Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY) for comprehensive development of Scheduled Castes majority villages. As the Scheme relies heavily on convergence with other Schemes of the Centre to achieve saturation in the selected villages against the identified 50 indicators, it is very crucial for the all the selected central schemes to leverage their schemes for giving priority to the PMAGY villages.

3. Further, it has been stated by M/o Social Justice and Empowerment that through a need assessment survey conducted by the Ministry, a total of 4,22,706 beneficiaries have been identified under Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY) for providing shelter to those households living in Kachha/unsafe houses through Prathan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) of Rural Development.

4. Therefore, you are requested to direct the officer/official concerned looking after PMAY-G to work in co-ordination with the District Social Welfare officer looking after Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana and also to identify the eligible PMAY-G beneficiaries from the universe of 4,22,706 PMAGY beneficiaries for the saturation of these identified villages and provide the details on the following to this Ministry at the earliest :

(i) whether the identified beneficiaries under PMAGY are same as PMAY-G beneficiaries

(ii)Number of works referred to PMAY-G

- (iii) Number of works that were sanctioned
- (iv) Balance, and

(v) Action Plan for sanctioning the others and if not the reasons.

5. Further, it is requested that the above information may be sent via email at chahat.singh@gov.in and a copy marked to pmu.ruralhousing@gmail.com by 15th October, 2020. State/UTs are also requested to complete the sanctioning of houses to eligible households as per the FFI of PMAY-G by December, 2020 and to provide an action

plan/timelines as to how the State/UT plans to complete the target within the set time period.
